In 1987, the Alliance initiated a mini-grant education fund as a financial resource for teachers to develop innovative classroom projects. This year, 15 teachers were granted partial funding for ideas they submitted to the Greater Williamsburg Chamber & Tourism Alliance Annual Mini-Grant Program. A total of \$5,039 was awarded for specific projects in conjunction with their regular classroom work.

The Alliance received 42 applications from teachers throughout the Historic Triangle. All public and private schools in Williamsburg, James City County and York County were eligible to apply. Funding for the program was provided by Alliance events and sponsorships.
