The event will provide area residents and members of the business community the opportunity to hear from our lawmakers about the status of legislation proposed during this year's regular session and issues anticipated for the Reconvened Session that is scheduled for April 8.

Questions and discussion will be facilitated by Mark Duncan, chair of the Alliance's Government Affairs Committee.
